

# Contract FAQ

Q: Why does my salary seem to look less than my annual pay last year?

A: In the past, the amount that is considered supplemental pay for the classroom site fund (301) was imbedded into the salary schedule. This year, we are breaking out your base pay and the supplemental pay, to show you what amount is dependent upon State funding.

Q: What happened to my (longevity...master's...) stipend?

A: The contract only reflects your annual salary amount. Any stipends that you are eligible for will show as separate line items on your pay.

Q: I thought that we were going to get a 3% increase. Where does that show up?

A: The Governing Board approved a 3% pay raise for the TEA Consensus on June 14, 2011. The new salary schedule was calculated with that 3% increase, so already includes that amount.

Q: How long do I have to accept my contract?

A: You have 15 days to accept your contract.
